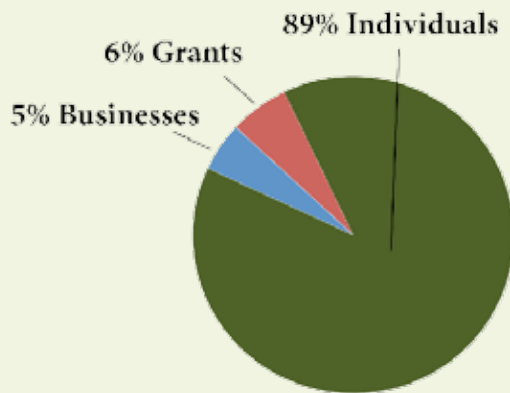
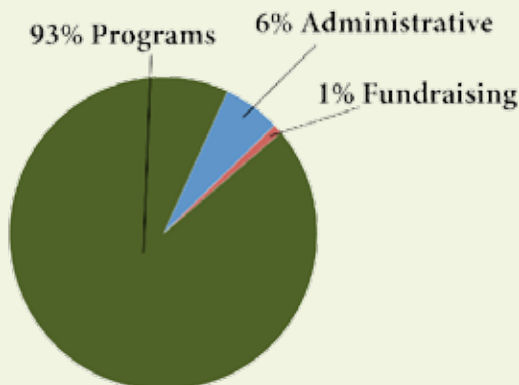


LOAVES & FISHES MISSION STATEMENT

FOOD

The dining room serves a filling hot lunch 364 days of year. 171,773 lunches were served this year. Women and children were served 22,678 hot breakfasts. 323,000 cups of hot coffee were poured.

WARMTH

Maryhouse provided 3,345 women and children with a warm, safe, and caring place to be. 171 homeless children were provided emergency schooling. 9,967 Full service showers were given to women and 29,178 were given to men. 5,424 mental health counseling sessions were given. 22 chronically homeless mentally ill women were given overnight shelter.

a path HOME

Mustard Seed School enrolled 125 children back into public schools. 77 women and families were connected with and able to move into their own apartments or homes.

COMMUNITY

Over 1,000 community members come each month to volunteer their time. 2,891 community members were activated in advocating for the homeless. 12,920 lbs of food were received each month from the community.

THE WHO

Our guests were surveyed so that we could better understand their circumstances. We found that...

- Half of our guests are aged 50 or older
- 63% are sleeping outside without shelter
- 53% reported psychiatric disabilities such as schizophrenia, bipolar disorder, anxiety, etc...
