The HR Generalist works onsite in a private office as Loaves & Fishes is an essential service provider. Responsibilities include:

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Foster a teamwork/open-door environment conducive to positive dialogue across Loaves & Fishes
- Advocate on behalf of staff and promote equity at Loaves & Fishes
- Assist and support program directors in writing job postings, recruitment, screening and interviewing of applicants
- Conduct new employee orientations/meetings with a focus on the mission, history and philosophy of Loaves & Fishes
- Collaborate with fiscal team to negotiate benefits packages and present to new eligible employees
- Compassionately listen, mediate, document and respond to employee complaints, grievances and disputes
- Collaborate with ED and program directors to facilitate employee discipline processes
- Assist program directors in identifying and providing staff trainings as needed
- Support planning of organization-wide retreats, employee morale events, etc.
- Maintain human resource information and employee files
- Maintain current knowledge of labor requirements and compliance as related to HR functions
- Other duties as assigned
