

Warehouse Crew Member

Under the direction of the Warehouse Director, all warehouse crew members are responsible for the daily duties of the warehouse. This includes inventory documentation, receiving & distributing donations, warehouse maintenance, donation pick-ups, and offer assistance to Loaves & Fishes programs & services.

Typical duties include, but are not limited to:

- 1. Manage First In, First Out (FIFO) method of distributing inventory
- 2. Maintain equipment and safety logs at all times
- 3. Receive donations, stock shelves, pull & deliver program orders
- 4. Distribute donations according to Warehouse Directors instructions
- 5. Warehouse maintenance, cleaning and compliance with CAL OSHA
- 6. Daily interaction with donors and vendors
- 7. Other duties as assigned

Requirements:

- 1. Must have a valid CA driver's license & provide a current MVR
- 2. Must be Forklift Certified, proof required
- 3. Must have proficient writing & communication skills
- 4. Must be familiar with Inventory processes & documentation
- 5. Must be able to work holidays & weekends (Nov Jan)
- 6. Must be familiar with Cal OSHA requirements
- 7. Experience with food handling is a plus, Food Handler's certification is required
- 8. Must have the ability to work as part of a team and independently
- 9. Must be able to follow instructions
- 10. Must be able to lift 30-50 lbs without limitations
- 11. Computer skills with Microsoft Word, Excel & Access database
- 12. Prior warehouse experience preferred

Qualities required:

Commitment to the mission and philosophy of Loaves & Fishes.

The candidate must be detail oriented, possess strong written and oral communication skills, and strong organizational and computer skills. Ability to be a self- starter, work independently, and meet deadlines. Candidate must be accuracy oriented.
