Genesis provides intensive, no-barrier mental health counseling and support services to our guests. This position is fully on-site.

Responsibilities:

- Provide hospitable and compassionate service, as point of contact for vulnerable homeless population accessing mental health services.
- Intensive individual counseling
- Crisis intervention and trauma-informed approach
- Maintain caseload of regular weekly and bi-weekly appointments as well as walk-ins
- Onsite outreach to various programs within the Loaves & Fishes property
- Abide by APA/NASW Code of Ethics & Principals and HIPAA laws
- Data reporting using Genesis database and charting progress notes
- Communication/collaboration with area social service providers
- Referrals to other service providers as needed
- Other duties as assigned.

- Master's level education in the mental health field (MSW/MFT degree, licensure a plus)
- Ability to maintain strong personal and professional boundaries
- Willingness to meet the demands of vulnerable guests experiencing homelessness

- Excellent verbal and written communication skills to meet professional requirements
- Must be able to work independently and collaboratively as part of a team as well as with various programs and service providers
