Sacramento Loaves & Fishes is a non-profit organization providing survival services to people experiencing homelessness in a spirit of love, radical hospitality and generosity to all those seeking assistance.

Genesis Mental Health provides intensive, no-barrier mental health counseling and support services to our guests. We are currently seeking a Master's-level Therapist for our Genesis Mental Health program. The Therapist position is a non-exempt position reporting to the Genesis Mental Health Program Director. We can be somewhat flexible with the scheduled days of the week but prefer a consistent weekly schedule. Mornings tend to be the program's busiest time. Licensure is strongly preferred. This position is fully on-campus.

Mission Statement: In an environment of welcome, hospitality, safety and cleanliness, we seek to provide an oasis for homeless men, women and children seeking survival services.

Position Responsibilities:

- Provide hospitable and compassionate counseling services as point of contact for vulnerable homeless people accessing mental health services
- Provide intensive individual counseling
- Crisis intervention and trauma-informed approach
- Maintain caseload of regular weekly and bi-weekly appointments as well as walk-ins
- Onsite independent outreach to various programs within the Loaves & Fishes property
- Abide by APA/NASW Code of Ethics & Principals and HIPAA laws
- Maintain detailed confidential records using Genesis database and charting progress notes
- Communication/collaboration with area social service providers
- Referrals to other service providers as needed
- Supervision of interns as needed
- Other duties as assigned

Required Skills:

- Knowledge of and personal commitment to the mission of Loaves & Fishes
- Ability to maintain strong personal and professional boundaries
- Willingness to meet the demands of vulnerable guests experiencing homelessness
- Crisis intervention and de-escalation skills
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills to meet professional requirements
- Must be able to work independently and collaboratively as part of a team as well as with various programs and service providers



- Experience with Microsoft Office programs (Excel, Word, Access, etc.) and Google Suite
- Knowledge of confidentiality practices (compliance with HIPAA laws)
- Willingness to supervise Master's-level interns as needed
- Must be willing to work 100% on-site

Qualifications:

- Master's-level education in the mental health field required (MSW/MFT or other comparable degree)
- Licensure is strongly preferred but 3+ years of relevant work experience and/or candidates collecting hours towards licensure will be considered

Physical Requirements:

- Intermittent sitting, standing and walking throughout the day
